


After teeing off, the player with the disc farthest from the basket throws first.

Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the lie.

A run-up and follow-through is allowed.

Any disc that comes to rest above the ground is considered an unplayable lie.

The disc must be thrown from underneath the unplayable lie.

Remove your disc carefully to avoid damage to the vegetation.

Help new players play by the rules and keep the course clean of litter.

Note: mosquitoes and/or deer ticks may be encountered on the course.
