

**TOWN OF PITTSFORD SELECT BOARD PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES August 18, 2021**

The Public Concerns Hearing was called to order at 7:33 PM by Chair Alicia Malay.

This was a presentation by the Sidewalk Scoping Committee participants. This project is funded through VTrans grant funds. Residents are being asked to complete a survey ([tinyurl.com/Pittsfordsurvey](https://tinyurl.com/Pittsfordsurvey)) for valuable input that can be used to aid in this project.

Mr. Crites, representing DuBois & King, explained through a PowerPoint presentation that Pittsford is considering upgrading its sidewalk network. Sidewalks are being considered for Plains Road, Mechanic Street, Pinewoods, Terounzo Road and Arch Street. There are studies being conducted focusing on vegetation, topography, benefits, and local impacts.

D. Mills inquired about the intersection of U S Route 7 with Pinewoods Road and recommended a possible loop to follow along Route 7 to Plains Road, being wide enough for bikes and pedestrians.

T. Hooker proposed that the area of Mechanic Street be replaced by evaluation of the unfinished remainder of Pleasant Street.

J. Haverstock explained that the survey would be publicized in the next newsletter and a mailing of information would be sent to residents that might be impacted by the potential sidewalks.

The Public Concerns Hearing was adjourned at 8:08 PM.
