Application 1R1025 from Boondock Motors, Inc., Travis & Erica Bovey 670 Hollister Quarry Road, Brandon, VT 05733 was received on October 21, 2022, and deemed complete on January 27, 2023. The project is generally described as approval to conduct commercial operations on a 3.2-acre lot for commercial auto repair, towing and recovery services. Applicant conducts repair operations Monday through Saturday between 7:00AM and 6:00PM with occasional repairs being performed (as needed) on Sundays. Towing/recovery services take place 7 days per week, 24 hours a day. Applicant also seeks approval for the installation of a replacement septic system (as permitted under WW-1-3583) and minor site modifications including landscaping and the construction of a privacy fence along the eastern property boundary line. A single-family residence on the property is excluded from this application.

The project is located at 670 Hollister Quarry Road in Pittsford, Vermont.

Issues raised in the request include Criteria 1, 1B, 5, and 8. The Applicants are also seeking to reduce the size of the jurisdictional Tract pursuant to the Stonybrook doctrine. The Commission intends to narrow the scope of the hearing those Criteria unless that scope is expanded either by the request of a Party or by the Commission at the hearing.
