INVITATION FOR BIDS

March 24, 2026

RE: FY 2026-2027 Sidewalk Paving Project

Sealed bids for furnishing the items below will be received at the Office of the Town Manager of the Town of Pittsford, Vermont, at the above address, until April 10, 2026 at 10:00 AM. At that time, they will be opened and read. Proposals should be in a sealed envelope marked Pittsford Paving Proposal. Contractors must list cost per ton of asphalt in place and the estimated amount of tons to be used. There must be an overall total bid price submitted, to include all paving. All materials must meet State specifications for each component material. The Town will accept and consider bids including 15% **RAP** in the proposed paving mix. Contractors must provide proof of certificate of insurance with their bids.

Contractors must contact Pittsford Highway Foreman for specifications regarding the paving jobs and roads. The Highway Foreman, Chad Eugair, can be reached at the Town Highway Garage at (802) 483-6886.

Selection of the contractor will be based upon bidders' qualifications, including evidence of past performance in similar projects, i.e.: availability of prompt, workmanlike service and bid price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder deemed by the Town to be the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

The successful bidder shall complete all of the work, and deliver all of the equipment, supplies and materials on or before October 15, 2026. Payment will be made within 30 days of the completion of work and submission of an invoice.

Paving projects need to be scheduled between July 1st and October 15.

Contractors will provide daily slips of tonnage and roads paved to the Town Highway Foreman, so that the Town can keep an accurate account of what has been paved, when it was paved, and the cost for paving each road. Paving must meet State specifications. The Town reserves the right to have an independent firm testing the quality of the paving work done.

The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturday, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids.

The Town reserves the right to waive any informalities, to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any or all bids, or take whatever other action may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.
